

Adding Package BO to Existing Package Combinations

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About this Guide

This document explains how to create the Business Object Documents (bo) package and make it available in existing package combinations in ERP LN 6.1.

The Package Business Object Documents (bo) is released for ERP LN 6.1. This document provides the steps you must take to create the package and make it available in existing package combinations; before you install the PMC solution, these steps must be completed.

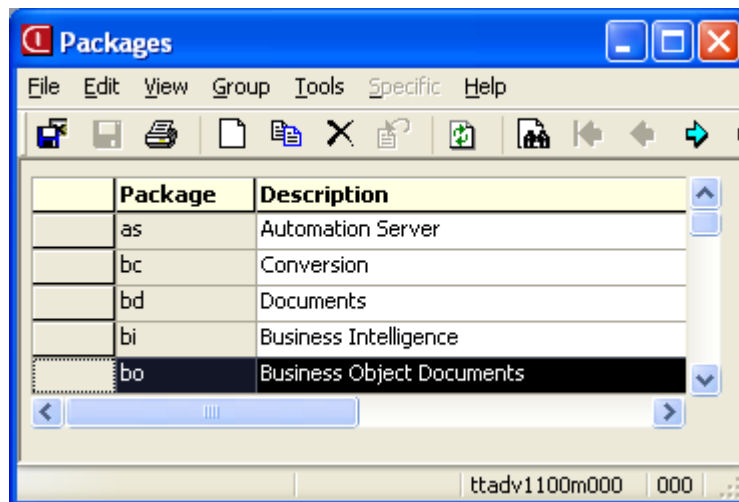
Adding Package bo to your Package Combinations

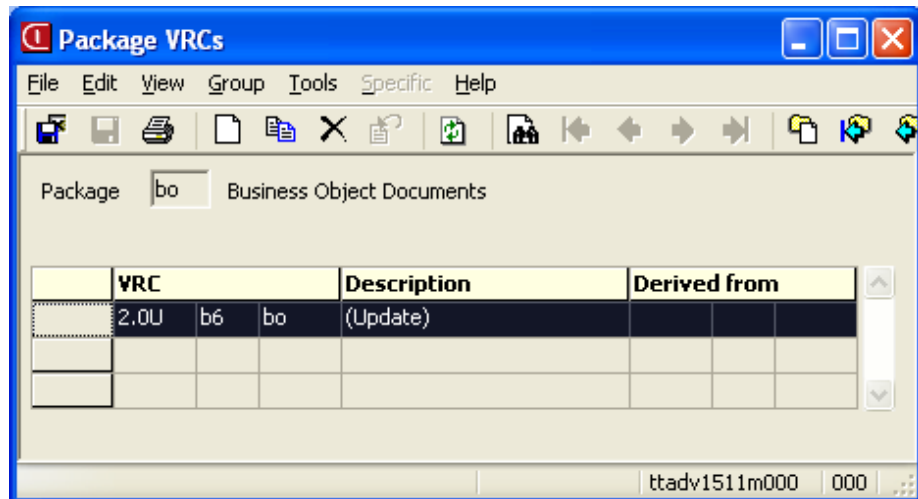
To create a new Package VRC and add it to the Package Combination, complete the following steps.

IMPORTANT: Before you install the PMC solution, complete the following steps.

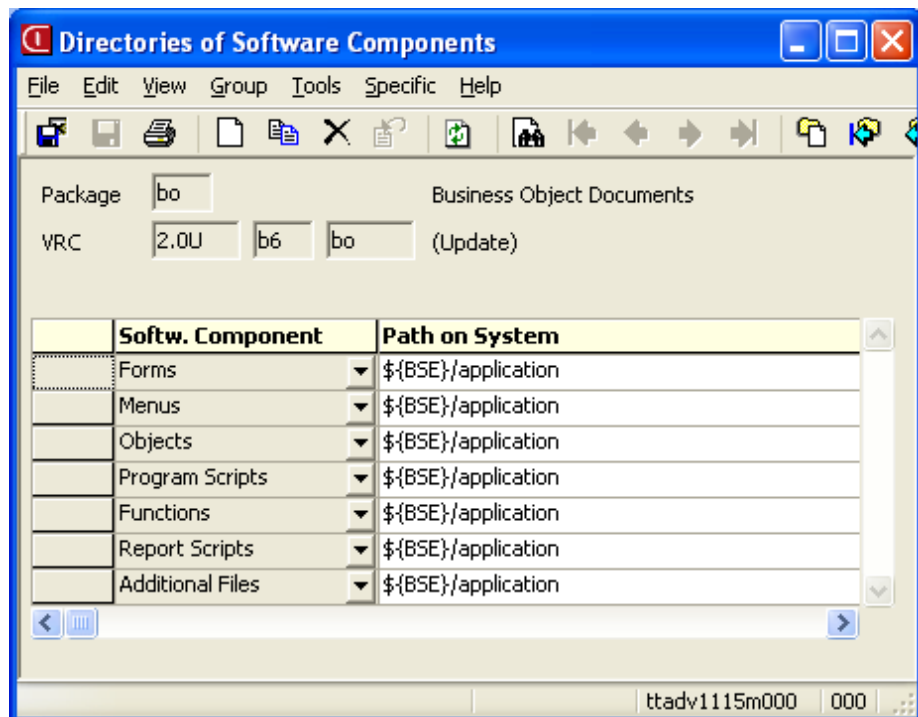
- 1 Start the Packages (ttadv1100m000) session and add the new Package bo, as shown here.



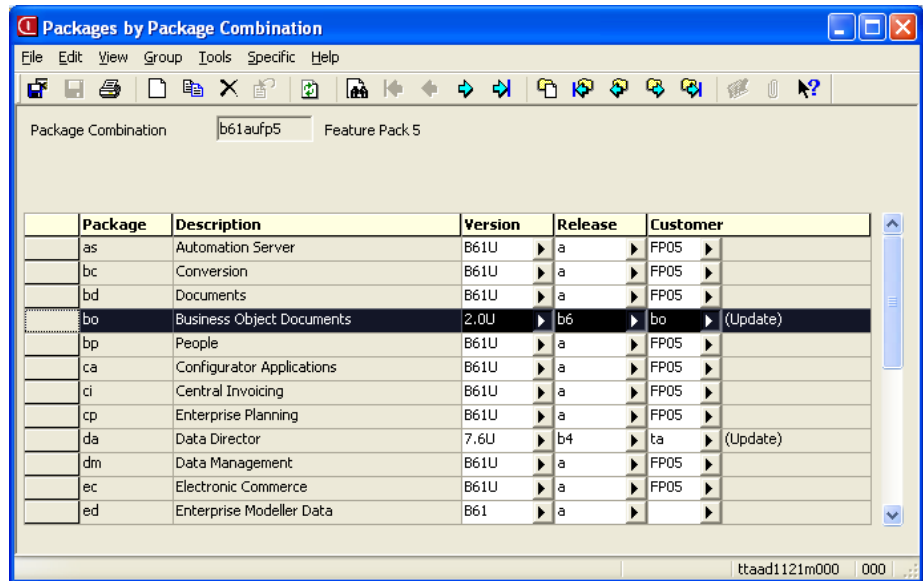
- 2 Start the Package VRCs (ttadv1511m000) session. Create a new VRC 2.0U b6 bo for Package bo. The status of the VRC should be set to Released. An example of the new Package VRC is as follows:



- 3 Start the Directories of Software Components (ttadv1115m000) session and enter the directories for the VRC.

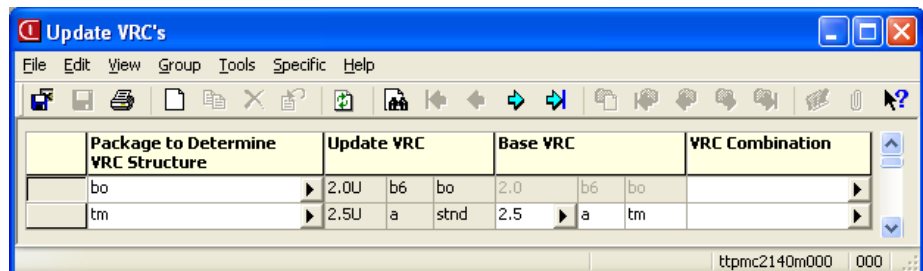


- 4 In the Packages by Package Combination (ttaad1121m000) session, include the new Package VRC in all Package Combinations that will use the functionality from the Business Object Documents.



Note: If you do not require SOA functionality, you need not include the bo package in your Package Combination.

- 5 Save the modification. To rebuild the data dictionary, start option Rebuild DD from the Specific menu.
- 6 Start the Update VRC's (ttpmc2140m000) session. Create a new Update VRC 2.0U b6 bo for Package bo. The Base VRC should be set to 2.0 b6 bo. An example of the new Update Package VRC is as follows:



After you have completed the process, you must log on again.
