Deployment

Platform Support

HP-UX PA RISC will not be supported anymore.

Virtualization

Citrix XenServer 6 is now supported. It requires a portingset 8.8a.02 and SLM 7.3.0.2 or higher.

Four digit company number

When the LN implementation has extensive company numbers, it is now possible to extend the company numbers to four digits. To enable four digit company numbers, you must add the line `extended_company_range=1` in the `all` file located in the `$BSE/lib/defaults` folder.

Currently the installation wizard cannot install demo companies in a four digit company number.

SLM

SLM 7.3.0.2 has Citrix XenServer 6 support.

ASM

ASM 1.8 has Citrix XenServer support and is only available in 64-bit support.

Integrations

Infor Reporting

Infor Reporting provides a complete, server-based platform for adopting solutions to design and deliver reports and forms that are required to manage the day to day operations of an organization from a departmental perspective. The integration is built to use the power of Infor Reporting in an LN environment. The LN session reports can be redesigned as an Infor Reporting report design, which provides a modern layout with all types of features such as images, indicators, and graphs. You can deploy these reports to a central report server. To use a report design that is stored on the report server, LN users can print the corresponding LN report to an Infor Reporting device.

InContext Modeler

With the InContext Modeler you can create integration between Infor LN and several Infor Workspace web parts. This integration is based on so-called context messages. In those context messages the characteristics of the Infor LN objects, which have focus in the UI, are sent to the web parts. Those web parts have functionality to display the data that is related to the Infor LN objects.

Integration examples:

- An address of a Business Partner (BP). When you look up this BP, the Map web part will show his location.
- A Sales order can have many documents attached. This also applies to the BP for which the Sales Order applies. The Content Assistant web part shows both the documents attached to the Sales Order and the BP.

Enterprise Server Extensions – Web UI

Tools

The tools package contains the new mtm module. This module contains code for new future functionality and is not supported.

Application Studio

Application Studio contains these enhancements / changes:

- Code completion and text hover for messages and questions.
- The End activity action has been moved to a background job.
- To edit InContext models, new editors have been added.
- New option to exclude comments in application search.

Business Studio

Business Studio contains these enhancements / changes:

- An extra option, to hide the changes of the hidden objects, has been added to the Update Specialization process.
- When editing an attribute implementation hook, the used attributes are available in a list control besides the text window. You can double-click on a used attribute to add it in the text.

Reporting Studio

No changes
